



Vote now for your favourite projects!

If you're 16 years or over and living in NSW, you can have your say on projects in your area that will be funded through My Community Project, through the public vote that is open now.

To vote, you'll need:

- a MyServiceNSW Account
- your Medicare card to verify your name and age
- your NSW residential address to identify your electorate.

You'll need to pick between three and five projects in your electorate, arrange them in order of your preference, then submit your vote.

The projects with the most community support through the public vote will receive funding. You can vote at mycommunityproject.service.nsw.gov.au or a Service NSW Centre near you.
