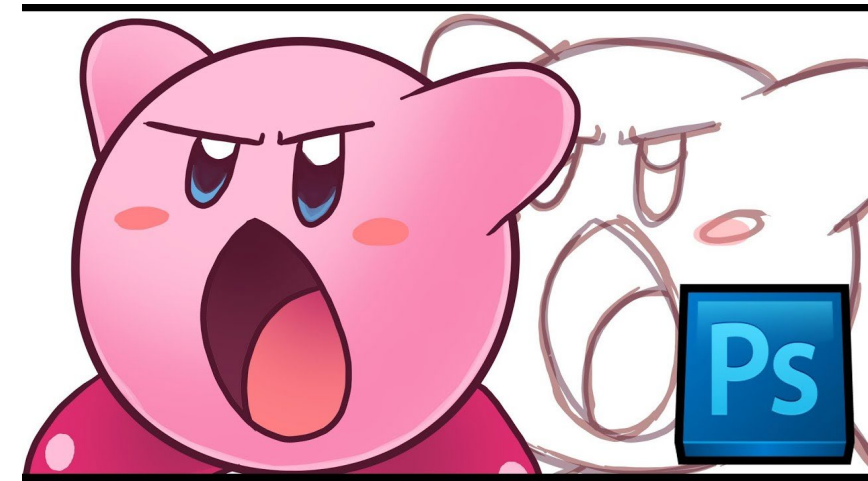
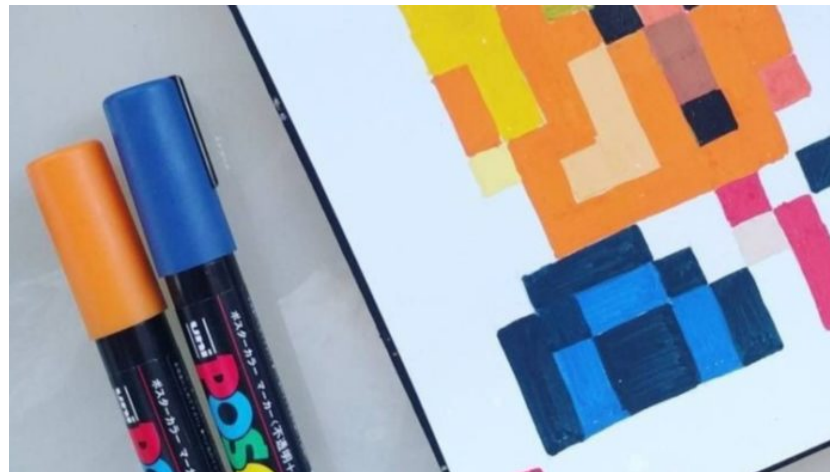
What is Visual Design?

Students will explore forms such as drawing, painting, printmaking, ceramics, sculpture, mixed media, installation and digital photography.



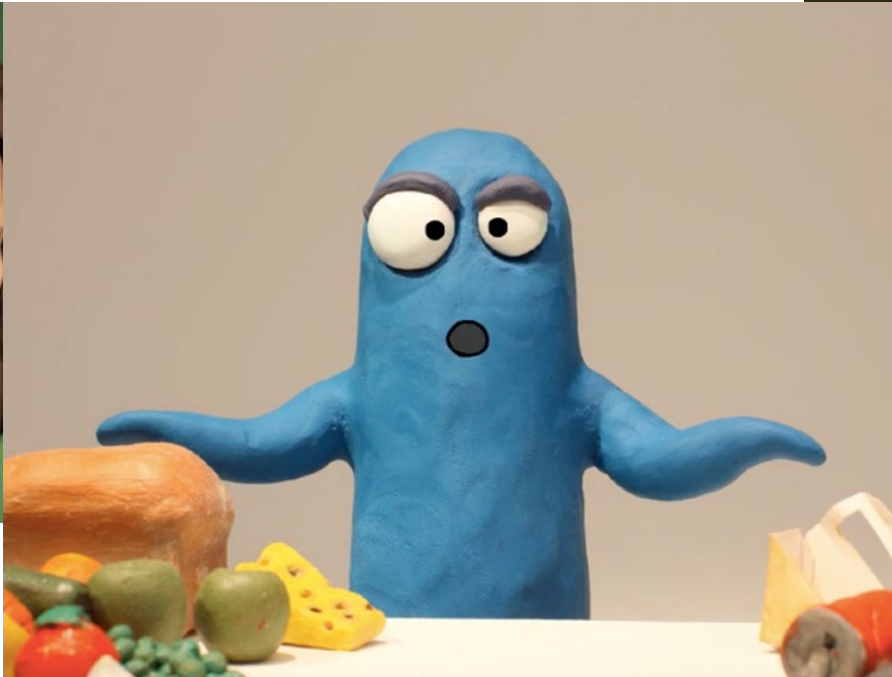
Imagining a Band Identity

Claymation - Clay animation based on social issue; constructing and animating characters/sets.



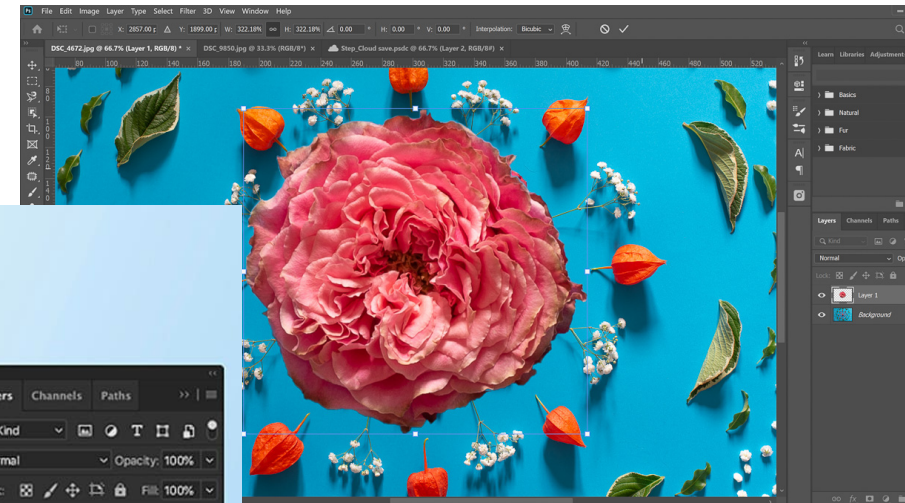
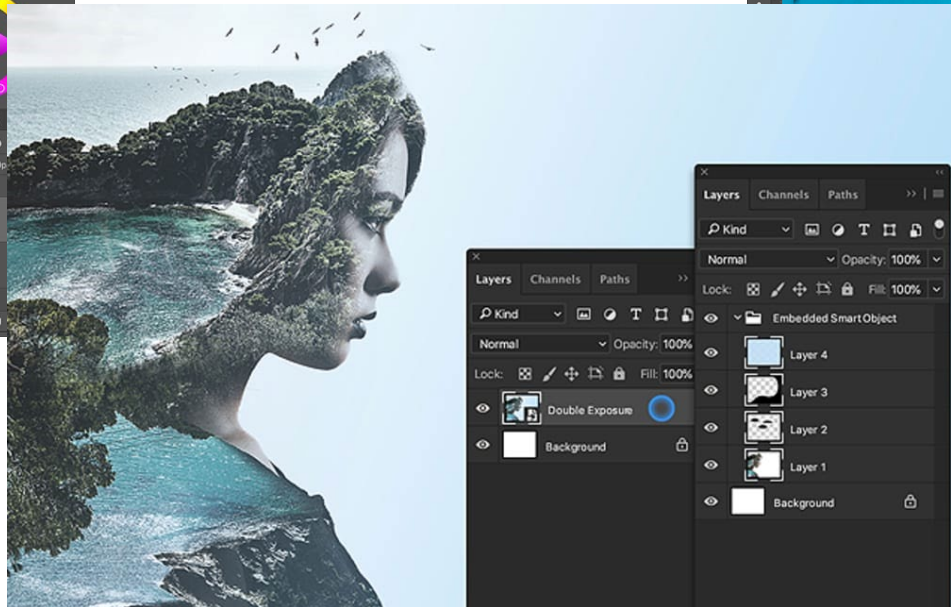
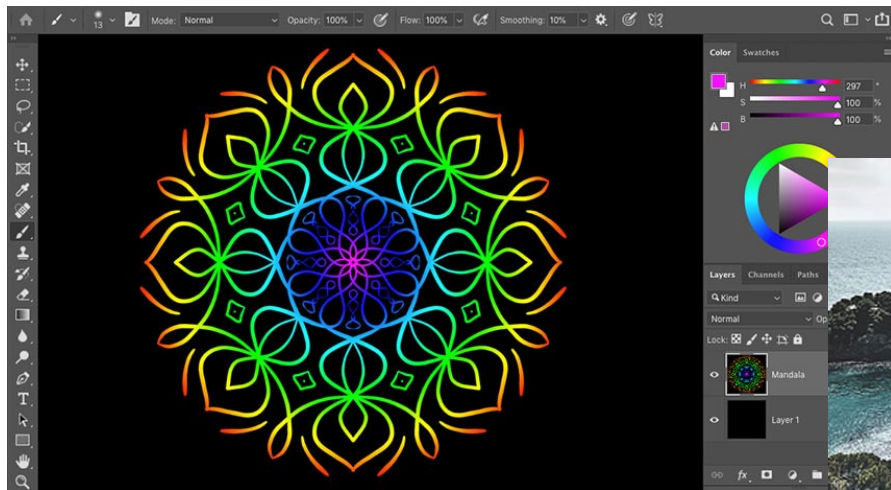
Wearables

Computer Graphics – Learn how to use Photoshop.



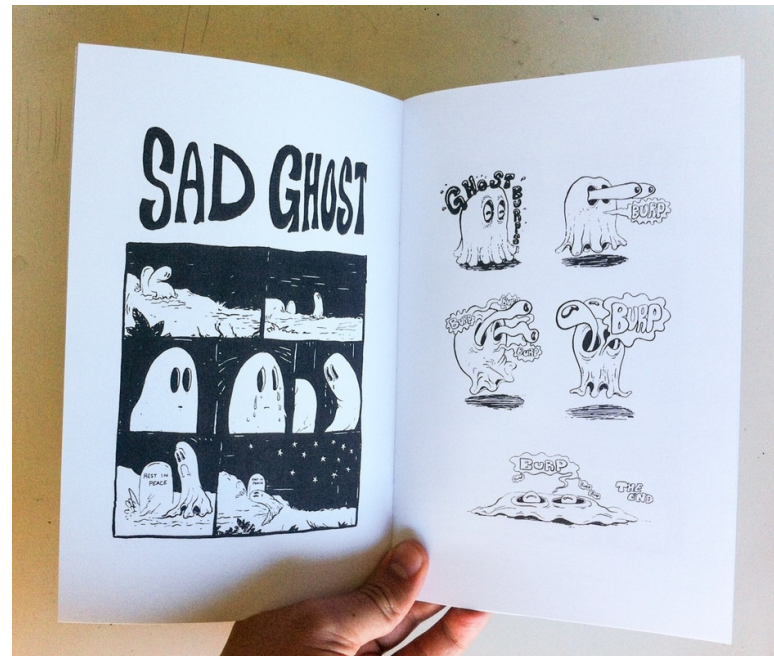
Finder's Keepers

Finder's Keepers – Functional object design from found/recycled materials.



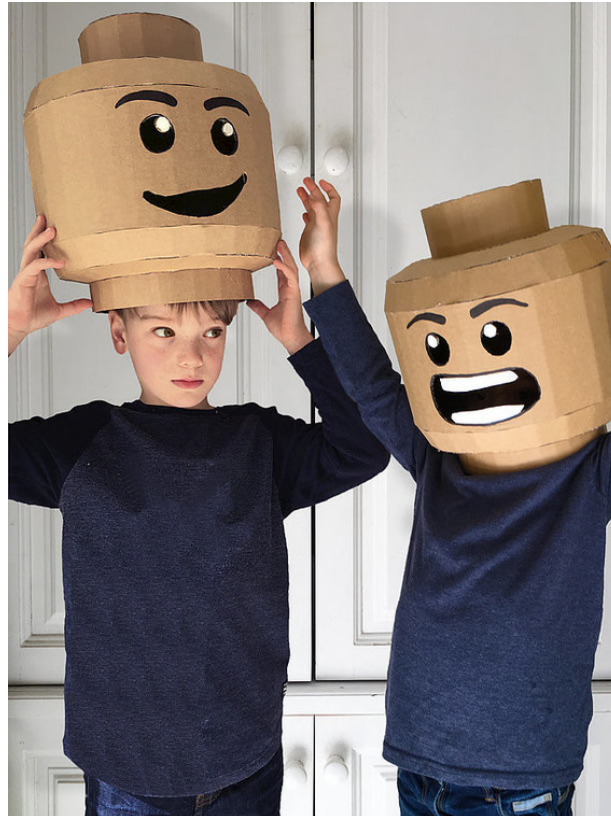
Comic Illustration
